Adapted from George Bernard Shaw’s play and Gabriel Pascal’s motion picture *Pygmalion*, this classic Broadway musical is reinvented into a fresh new production with a 10 person cast and two pianos. We will offer a Talkback directly following the Sunday, September 21 performance moderated by Michael Anthony Adams from the *Indianapolis Star* and featuring the cast/production crew of *My Fair Lady* with special guest, Patricia Wilson, author of “Yesterday’s Mashed Potatoes: The Fabulous Life of a Happy Has-Been.”
